WEST END PROSPECTORS CLUB INCORPORATED RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules:

- 1. Dog owners must control their animals at all times.
- 2. No wearing of firearms allowed in camp. Shooting to follow local restrictions with precautions. Remove your firearm upon returning to camp and stow in your vehicle.
- 3. "Quiet Time" is 10:00 pm to 8:00 am. No generators, loud music or noises. Campfire chat is not offensive.
- 4. Trash, you bring it in, you carry it out.
- 5. Open fires must comply with local rules and regulations.

Prospecting Rules:

- 1. The maximum size of a dredge is limited only by the Fish and Game regulations for a particular claim.
- 2. Any equipment is legal as long as it is hand fed with a shovel.
- 3. Your work site must have a fire extinguisher.
- 4. Clear 10-foot circle of combustibles around your gas engine.
- 5. Engines must have an approved spark arrestor.
- 6. A shovel for fire control.
- 7. All prospecting holes must be filled and restored to as near as natural condition as possible.
- 8. When prospecting, allow other prospectors a 25 foot buffer area. Of course, if agreeable to parties present, the 25-foot rule can be disregarded.
- 9. When a member breaks down his equipment and leaves the claim, the spot he had been working becomes open to all other members.
- 10. Members are not to prospect on adjoining claims unless they are a guest of the owner or a member of the group that owns the claim.

Blasting:

No blasting allowed, unless approved by board of directors and you must have the required state license.

Appropriate Behavior:

No vulgar or obscene language used in camp. WEPC is a family organization.

Membership:

 Annual fees are due July 1st. A late fee is assessed July 31st of \$5; payment not received by August 31st an additional \$10 late fee is assessed. If not paid by Sept. Board meeting - membership is dropped. Extension or reinstatement subject to review by board.
